

Biblical–Abrahamic Historical Timeline

Moses and the Exodus from Egypt → Wandering in Sinai (40 years)

Moses views the Promised Land from afar and dies outside it

Joshua succeeds Moses and leads the Conquest of Canaan

Period of the Judges → Samuel emerges as prophet

Saul becomes first king; David defeats Goliath and captures Jerusalem

Solomon builds the First Temple; Ark of the Covenant placed inside

Kingdom splits: Israel (north) and Judah (south)

Assyria destroys Northern Kingdom (Israel)

Babylon destroys Judah and the First Temple; Exile


Cyrus of Persia allows return; Second Temple built

Alexander the Great conquers the region; Hellenistic rule

Maccabean revolt leads to independent Jewish kingdom

Roman conquest; Second Temple destroyed (70 CE); Diaspora
